A board-certified family nurse practitioner with advanced training in aesthetic medicine, Brittany brings a refined, patient-first philosophy to the world of cosmetic care.

After years of working in Los Angeles and training under some of the country's top aesthetic providers, she returned to her native Florida in 2017 determined to offer something different.

"I wanted to create a space where people felt comfortable—where aesthetic care is thoughtful and not aggressive," says Brittany. "Our approach is about balance, education and results that feel authentic to each patient."

Unlike high-volume medical spas that offer an exhaustive menu of services, Aesthetic Lane specializes in just three core areas:

- **Wrinkle Relaxers** (such as Botox and Dysport) to soften fine lines.
- **Dermal Fillers** (such as Juvéderm and Restylane) to restore facial structure and harmony.
- **Biostimulators** (such as Sculptra and Radiesse)
- **Skin Rejuvenation** that uses chemical peels, medical-grade skincare, and advanced microneedling to improve tone and texture.

This focused expertise allows Brittany and her team to provide deeply customized treatment plans without pressure or upselling. "We start with a full-face consultation and create

a timeline," she says. "Some results are immediate, while others develop over weeks or months. The goal is always long-term facial harmony—not a quick fix."

Aesthetic Lane uses only FDA-cleared devices, including the latest generation of the SkinPen, a microneedling tool that stimulates collagen and enhances skin renewal.

"Collagen production slows in our 30s, regardless of skin type," notes Brittany. "Microneedling is one of the most universally beneficial treatments we offer. It's clinical, effective, and safe when performed properly."

Brittany's credentials support her measured approach. She earned her nursing degree from Florida State University and completed her master's degree at the University of Tampa. Her background includes experience in intensive care as well as advanced aesthetic training through Allergan's clinical education program.

Her team—comprised entirely of board-certified medical professionals—prioritizes ongoing education through manufacturer training and peer collaboration, ensuring that patients receive the most current and effective treatments available.

Education doesn't end at the consultation. Patients are sent home with detailed aftercare and lifestyle guidance to help preserve results between treatments. "Aesthetic care is collaborative. Sleep, nutrition, and skincare matter just as much as what we do in the office," adds Brittany.
